Encounter Week 2023 - July 3-7

We are excited about camp and look forward to a great week! In order for us to go to camp, we are required to have at least one(1) adult for every eight(8) campers. Also, in an effort to make registration easier and to catch up with the times, all camp registrations are being done online.

Online Registration

1. Individuals will be able to fill out the medical release and consent form online according to the week you are attending (Encounter Week, July 3-7) and the church you are attending with (Good Hope Baptist Church). A \$20 Pre-Registration fee is due NO LATER than May 21st. The remaining \$155 is due by June 25th. Late registration is an additional \$10. Please give money to Angela Raines for tracking purposes, it will then be passed to Bro. Billy.
2. The church contact (Angela Raines) will get an email of the form.
3. Adults (anyone 18 years and older) are required to complete the online Child Protection Training before filling out the form. You will receive a certificate via email and will be able to upload it with your form online. In addition, we are required to run a background check on all adults attending camp.
4. If you need assistance with this process, please let us know. We want to make sure that everyone who wants to go to camp gets to go, this includes financial assistance. Let Bro. John or Bro. Billy know if you need help with the camp fees or if you would like to give a scholarship to help someone go to camp.

Concession Stand

The camp will be able to accept credit cards at the concession stand now. Also, money bands may be purchased online and ahead of time in \$10 or \$20 bands and will be given to your child when they arrive at camp. (Be sure to let Angela know if you purchased a band for your child or would like one purchased for them at camp.) Any unused amount on the band at the end of the week can be turned in for cash.

Visitors and Camp Security

Complying with the state mandates and allowing visitors has been very difficult for the camp. They are trying something new for those with legitimate reasons to visit camp. The safety of the campers is our utmost priority.

1. Each camper will be given a wrist band to be worn through the week to identify them as a registered camper.
2. Visitor Policy
 - a. All visitors must check in at the camp office (the gate will be closed, a phone number will be posted for a visitor to call in and gain access to come directly to the office)
 - b. A visitor must be associated with a church in some way
 - c. A background check must be provided or one can be performed at the office for a fee
 - d. An adult visitor must be escorted at all times by a registered adult camper. Both will wear identifying badges.
